
THE GOAL

<u>Get excited about God's Word</u> <u>–Hidden Treasure!</u>

Proverbs 2 describes a child who is excited about God's Word— leaning and calling out for understanding, seeking wisdom like a hidden treasure and discovering the knowledge of God.

That's the COAL! Yes, we plan to provide games and prizes to motivate you to memorize important Bible verses. But we aim to challenge you with longer passages of the Bible. We have faith that whatever you memorize can have a powerful influence on you. We pray that you will have a love for God's Word and success in memorizing these passages.





- 2. Memorize the Bible references.
- 3. Memorize the verses exactly as they appear in the Bible (we recommend NASB version). Do not add, do not change and do not leave out any words.
- 4. Recite an entire assignment at one time to get it signed off by a leader or verse listener.
- 5. Recite an entire passage for double points!

Be diligent and aim for excellence!

Don't allow yourself to be content with even the smallest mistakes!

It's good training and worthwhile!

1. Ask God to help you! You have begun a great treasure hunt with guaranteed treasure from God! (Psalm 19:7-11, Proverbs 2:1,4-5)

2. Start memorizing early in the week. (Psalm 119:97) Don't save it all for the last minute! The goal is to learn the verses so well that you will remember them for a long time, hopefully even for the rest of your life!! (Psalm 119:11,16)

3. Let God speak to you through His Word. Pray that He will help you to understand the importance of His Word. Listen for Him! (Psalm 119:34)

4. Read over the passage every day, even when you don't have time to practice memorizing. Put the passage where you will see it-bathroom mirror, car, refrigerator, nightstand, ...you name it!

5. Get a friend or family member to quiz you through the week and help you/check that you are learning the verses correctly!)







HOW DOES IT WORK?

Start at the CrossWalk, follow-up at home

<u>Sundays</u> – CrossWalk will get the kids *started* on memorizing Bible Passages in the NASB version

Monday-Saturday - Parents please help your child:

- PRACTICE the passages
- BRING his/her CrossWalk book each Sunday
- Make extra copies of the verses and take Moses' advice in Deut 6:6-9...

"...teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

- Put them in places the kids will see them often— at the table (under a clear placemat?), in the car, bed headboard, on the bathroom or bedroom mirror.
- Establish a regular time to practice Summertime still has its routines... 1st thing in the morning or last thing at night, at breakfast, while brushing teeth., before TV or computer goes on!
- Just reading the passage once a day also helps get the heart and mind dwelling on God's Word.

RECITING VERSES FOR PRIZES

When Sundays - children recite their verses at break & CrossWalk to collect points for prizes at the prize table.

To whom

Your child can recite to CrossWalk leaders, parents, designated "CrossWalk Verse Listeners"

What

- > 1 POINT per verse for:
- Saying any part of a CrossWalk passage eg. any one verse in the Psalm 1 passage = 1 point
- Verse listeners initial and date on the line next to each verse recited correctly

AND...

- > DOUBLE POINTS!!!! per verse for:
- Reciting entire passage at one sitting with no more than about 3 prompts (eg. Psalm 1:1-6 = 12 points)!
 - Receive double points each time you recite a whole passage!
 - Eg. 36 points if you say Psalm 1:1-6 on 3 different Sundays!
